

The Stanley G. Tate Project STARS Program

Program Overview:

The Stanley G. Tate Project STARS (Scholarship Tuition for At-Risk Students) Program is the Foundation's hallmark program. Project STARS is a private-to-public scholarship program funded annually by the Florida Legislature and matched dollar-for-dollar by private donations. Participating organizations purchase Prepaid Plans and provide additional support through mentoring to help students reach their goals.

The program focuses efforts on low-income students who are at a higher risk of dropping out of school and prepares them to attend and succeed in college. All STARS scholars are assigned a mentor to guide them through their journey to higher education.

Interested donor organizations must complete the following:

- Submit a Pledge Letter to request matching funds
- Mail a check for 50% of the total contract plus a \$50 application fee for each contract purchased
- Provide proof of State of Florida Entity
- Provide the donor organization's focus or objective
- Agree to provide mentorship for students
- Agree to request approval from the Florida Prepaid College Foundation to use its logo
- Agree to allow the Florida Prepaid College Foundation use of your organization's logo on its website

Stanley Tate Project STARS scholarship recipients must meet the following criteria:

- An individual who is under the age of 21 and has not completed the 12th grade
- A resident of Florida for 12 consecutive months
- A United States citizen or a resident alien
- Scholarship recipients must have a valid SSN
- Economically disadvantaged- qualifies for free/reduced public school lunch program at time of selection/designation by the Donor (proof of eligibility required, via tax return or letter from non-Title 1 school)
- An individual that is at-risk of dropping out of school
- Agrees to remain drug and crime-free
- Graduate from an accredited Florida high school
- Agrees to meet with a mentor
- Agrees to submit an Annual Online Student Survey
